Our careers programme

Our vision is to raise every pupil's aspiration for the learning and careers opportunities open to them. We want pupils to be inspired by experiences of the work place, industry speakers and school based careers education. Furthermore we aim to help pupils understand the choices they need to make at Year 9 for their options and in Year 11 for further education and apprenticeships.

We have a full-time careers advisor, Mrs Hicks, who meets pupils from Year 9 upwards to provide personalised support.
