

LANGUAGES IN CANADA

Canada has two official languages: French and English. So Canadian stamps say 'Postes/Postage', instead of only 'Postage'. Most of the French-speaking Canadians live in the province of Quebec, which once belonged to France. The biggest city in Quebec is Montreal: it is four times as big as Ottawa, the capital of Canada.
