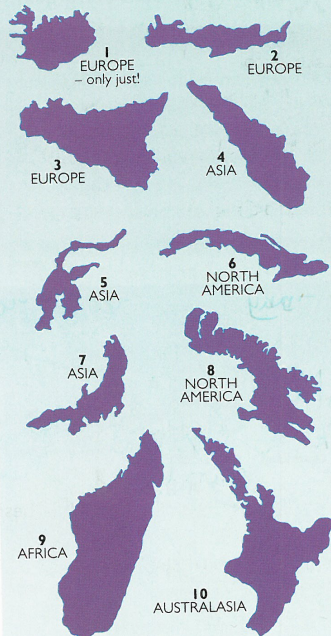
NAME THE COUNTRY
